THE JOB MARKET

Private Sector

- Offered by companies providing goods/service to make a profit.

Public Sector

- Usually service providers.

OPEN JOB MARKET VS. HIDDEN JOB MARKET

Open Job Market

- Jobs that are advertised; newspaper, signs, radios, internet.

Hidden Job Market

- Unadvertised jobs.
- Research is required to locate these jobs.

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Internal factors

- Factors within your personal life, school, workplace that affect your approach and potential for success.

External factors

- Factors that fall outside of your personal life, school and workplace.

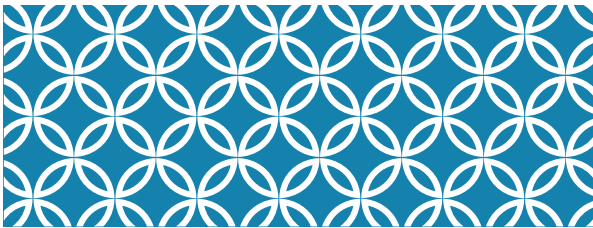
